Resolution RES-20110119.3: Transfer of Unused Playground Equipment to Portville Historical & Preservation Society

WHEREAS, General Municipal Law, Article 5-A, § 104-c enables the Town of Portville to transfer disposable computer-based devices and other unused, disposable equipment to governmental institutions, schools, libraries and certain not-for-profit organizations; and,

WHEREAS, The Town Board of the Town of Portville has determined that its stored, unused and unneeded playground equipment consisting of two cartoon-like spring-based ride-on horses is no longer a component of service or government delivery whether directly or indirectly, and,

WHEREAS, The Town Board of the Town of Portville desires that said equipment find productive use in a qualified entity within the community; and,

WHEREAS, The Town Board of the Town of Portville has been sought out by the Portville Historical & Preservation Society to donate said equipment for the possible use at its Bedford Corners one-room schoolhouse.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Town Board of the Town of Portville resolves that:

By vote of a majority of members of the Town Board of the Town of Portville, that the existing two cartoon-like spring-based ride-on horses located at its municipal building will be transferred within 30 days of the date of this resolution by the Town Clerk to the Portville Historical & Preservation Society for its ownership and use forthwith without encumbrances or fees.
