**TOWN OF PORTVILLE, NEW YORK
LOCAL LAW NO. 1 2010
A LOCAL LAW INCREASING THE TERM OF OFFICE OF THE TOWN SUPERVISOR
FROM TWO YEARS TO FOUR YEARS**

Section 1. STATUTORY AUTHORITY: This local law is adopted pursuant to the provision of the Municipal Home Rule Law of the State of New York.

Section 2. FOUR-YEAR TERM OF OFFICE: The term of office of the elected Town Supervisor shall be four years. Such four-year term shall commence as of the first day of January following the first biennial town election after the effective date of this local law.

Section 3. MANDATORY REFERENDUM: This local law is adopted subject to a mandatory referendum and shall be held for approval of the qualified voters of the Town of Portville at the biennial town election to be held November 2, 2010. A proposition in the following form shall be included on the ballot at such biennial town election, and the increased term of office shall not take effect unless such proposition is approved by a majority vote of the qualified voters voting thereon: "Shall Local Law No. 1 of the year 2010, entitled a Local Law Increasing the Term of Office of Town Supervisor from Two to Four Years" be approved?

Section 4. SUPERSESSSION: This local law shall supersede Town Law, §24 relating to the term of office of Town Supervisor of the Town of Portville.

Section 5. EFFECTIVE DATE: This local law shall become effective immediately upon being filed in the Office of Secretary of State after approval by the qualified voters.
